**The Kentuck Museum Association announces the next a la cARTe event, February 20, 2010 from noon to 2:00pm.** The February a la cARTe will feature a Kentuck Community Mosaic Project, Kentuck for Kids mosaic activity, and catering by Mary's Cakes & Pastries.

The Kentuck Community Mosaic Project will build a Kentuck mosaic for future installation at the Kentuck Art Center. A la cARTe participants are encouraged to bring item(s) from home (glass, ceramics, metal, plastics) to adorn the Kentuck mosaic.

The Kentuck for Kids mosaic activity will allow kids a chance to mosaic their very own original item to take home.

Mary's Cakes & Pastries will cater the event with a menu of french onion soup, fresh french bread, house-made soft cheese, madelines, profiteroles and king cakes. McAlister's Deli of Northport is generously donating the tea and lemonade.

In addition to Art Night, held on the first Thursday of each month, Kentuck monthly programming now includes the "a la cARTe series" on the third Saturday of each month.

Kentuck's "a la cARTe series" focuses on engaging the community and perpetuating the arts with art and conversation, artist demonstrations, Kentuck for Kids activities and regional cuisine. Designed to feature local businesses and Alabama food, the catering is provided by Kentuck partnerships with local restaurants, caterers and farms. Regional artists and art professionals give art talks and demonstrations while Kentuck for Kids feature a children's art activity. A la cARTe participants enjoy a 10% discount on Gallery Shop items during the event. The cost of \$10 goes toward Kentuck Artists Studio renovations.
